Year in Review

Dear HDS Community,

What a year 2020 has been and continues to be! From a global pandemic to nationwide unrest to natural disasters, the year is truly an unprecedented one. Through it all, however, Hickory Day School has remained true to its mission of instilling a love of learning in its students. We've certainly used many new methodologies and technologies to accomplish this sometimes daunting task, but we continue to provide the highest quality education both in our area and far beyond for our students.

Because of the dedication and forward thinking of the HDS faculty and staff during the winter of 2020, we were ready to move almost seamlessly into remote online learning upon our return from Spring Break on March 23, 2020. We spent a final quarter with students online, achieving a great deal in the process. One of the greatest thrills of the spring was being able to hold a live, on-campus Closing Ceremony and celebratory parade for our 2020 graduates, by far and away the largest graduating class that HDS has ever had since its beginning in 1993.

Already throughout the spring, planning for a different type of 2020 – 2021 school year was taking place. Although there were fears of what the financial future of the school might be as an anticipated recession loomed, we persevered. Fortunately, because of sound financial stewardship and generous contributions from the entire HDS community, the school ended its fiscal year on July 31 in a strong position.

The HDS budget is created in the fall of the previous year, and last November, we had no idea about what was to come. To prepare for the safest possible return in August, we had to make many adjustments to that budget. PPE supplies, deep cleaning and disinfecting measures, accommodations and technology for online students, storage for furniture once housed in classrooms, and especially a full-time custodian and hospital-quality air filtration units for every classroom all cost money – money that wasn't a part of the November budget.

As you think about everything that Hickory Day has done to create a safe and productive environment for its exemplary teaching and learning, I ask that you consider an early donation to the Annual Fund, one that will help ensure that these programs can continue and can grow as we face the rest of a challenging year.

I thank you for all your support in the past and for your support during this school year as we maintain and increase the excellence of a Hickory Day School education.

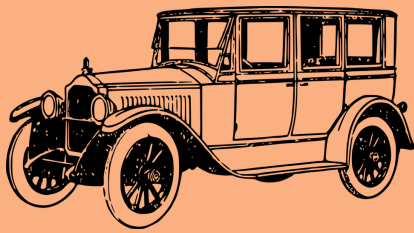

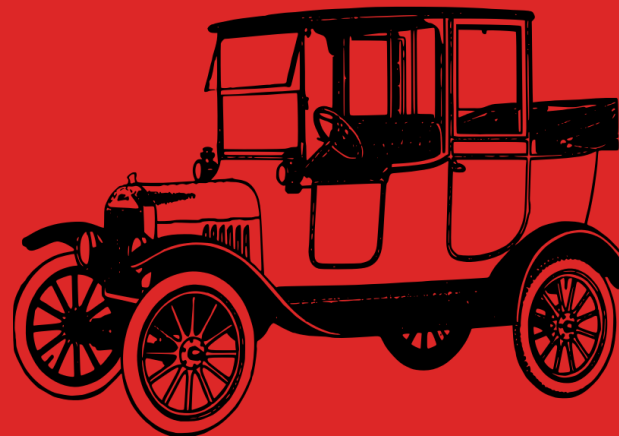

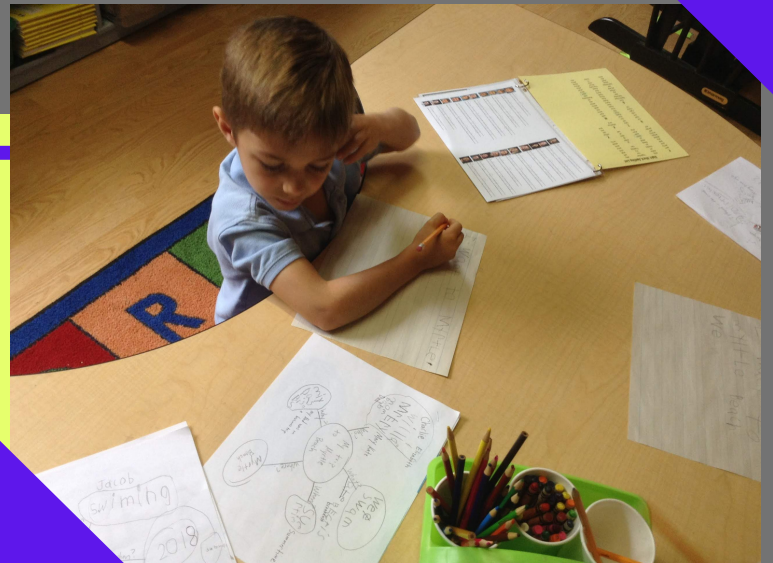
